Wednesday – Read: Exodus 15:1-15, Judges 5:1-31

Thursday – Read: Deuteronomy 31:30-32:47, Psalm 2

Friday – Read: 1 Samuel 2:1-10, Psalm 11, Psalm 20

Saturday – Read: 2 Samuel 22:1-51, Psalm 18

ENGAGE

What does your worship of God look like during the week? Do you take time to sing, to pray, to engage with God?

Is your worship time focusing on God and what you bring to Him, or on coming to God to ask and to get?

What steps do you take to “Be still and know that I am God?” What practical directions or environmental steps do you take to have a quiet time with God?

How much time do you spend with God compared to all your other activities?

CHALLENGE

This week’s challenge: **Keep a record of the time that you spend with God throughout the week and then evaluate and make a plan for future times together with Him. Then act on it.**
